

CLIL FOR OVERSEAS SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

COURSE OUTLINE: 50 HOURS, BLENDED LEARNING OPTION

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This six week course is ideal for secondary school teachers who teach their curriculum subjects in English. It includes four weeks online and two weeks face-to-face elements. The English level entry for this course is CEFR B1. Minimum group size is 6.

The online course is designed to improve the candidates' English language level before attending lessons at the school. It focuses on grammar and vocabulary, as well as the four skills (listening, speaking, reading & writing), and is designed to improve the candidates' level of English to CEFR B1+. This 4-week online course takes a minimum of 20 hours, although it could be longer if any sections need to be repeated.

The face-to-face course is taken over 2 weeks, Monday-Friday, and is a total of 30 hours. It is designed for secondary school teachers whose first language is not English, and will look at CLIL methodology, how the features of CLIL can be used in the classroom, and how to apply CLIL methodology to your own teaching context.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Candidates will first improve their overall understanding and use of English, before learning about both the practical and theoretical aspects of CLIL. Teachers will share their knowledge, and will gain a wider understanding of how to teach using the English language, allowing them to become a more confident and more able CLIL teacher.

SPECIFIC LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- have improved their level of English from B1 to B1+
- be aware of the features of CLIL
- identify how their current teaching methods need to be adapted
- be aware of the English language that they need
- be able to identify target vocabulary items needed to teach the curriculum in English
- be able to apply CLIL methodology to their own teaching context

TRAINING CONTENT

- 20 hours online English language practice (offered free of charge)
- 30 hours classroom practice

- English language level of CEFR B1.
