

STUDENT VISAS & WORK PERMITS

WORKING ON A STUDENT VISA IN SPAIN

- Students with a valid student residence permit can work in Spain part time (20 hours per week).
- Residence permits are only issued to students studying programs of two semesters or longer. Students studying for only one semester will not have a residence permit and are therefore not allowed to work.
- These rules also apply for paid and unpaid internships.

✓ Two semesters or more allowed to work

WORKING ON A STUDENT VISA IN SWITZERLAND

- Non-EU citizens are not allowed to work on a student visa in Switzerland.

WORKING ON A STUDENT VISA IN GERMANY

- Students enrolled at EU Munich are entitled to work 120 days full time or 240 days part time per year. Upon completion of their studies they can obtain a job seeking visa for a period of up to 18 months.
