Carl Duisberg Centren can not guarantee that the applicant receives payment by the company for services rendered. This mainly depends on the professional and language qualifications of the applicant, the duration of the practical training and the possibilities of the company.

Do you speak German and want an internship in Germany?

Carl Duisberg Centren offer language preparation courses in one of their training centers in Berlin, Cologne, Munich and Radolfzell, and organization of a 2 to 12 month internship in a company for citizens of EU states and Switzerland.

Requirements

- Minimum age: 22
- 3 years professional experience or an advanced course of specialized study
- Sound knowledge of the German language (B2)
- Submission of the application documents three months before the start of the language course

Internship Conditions

Professional qualifications

Applicants must have gained appropriate professional qualifications in the field they wish to have practical training. Qualifications are to be verified by:

- Certification of education/further education in the professional field
- Certification of number of years of practical experience in the appropriate professional field

Language qualifications

Applicants have or require good knowledge of the German language before taking up the practical training. The minimum required qualification is the telc B2 or equivalent examinations (around 600 teaching units).

Prior to the practical training, applicants participate successfully in a German Intensive Course Plus at a

Carl Duisberg Training Center in Germany for a period of at least four weeks. At the end they present at least the examination for telc B2. Applicants with less than the minimum language requirement should take further preliminary German language courses at the Carl Duisberg Centren to acquire the required language level. The arrangement of the practical training will take place in the month when the applicant has reached the language level of B2.

Application

Applicants send a dossier to the Carl Duisberg Training Center at least 3 months before the language course begins. The dossier contains the following information:

- A detailed curriculum vitae including reports or certification of school and professional education
- Reports or references for previous employers
- Certification of previous language acquisition (including all foreign languages)

- Completed questionnaire in German language with detailed explanation of applicant's requirements and wishes
- Application letter in German language

The Carl Duisberg Training Center offers each applicant, if possible, up to three suitable practical training placements. In case this is not possible the Carl Duisberg Training Center will inform the applicant before the beginning of the language course.

Companies offer the Carl Duisberg Training Center practical training according to the written applications of the applicant. The final decision, however, is made by the companies following a personal interview during the German language course. During courses which take place over several months the interview is conducted in the period where the applicant takes the examination telc B2. Carl Duisberg Centren cannot supply liability for placement.
