

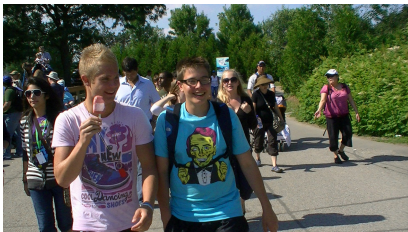
Toronto Junior Arrival and First Day



STUDENT ARRIVALS

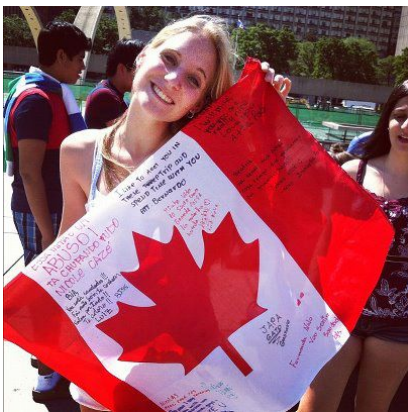
Students will be met by an EC transportation representative holding a sign with the EC logo. The EC transportation representative will be standing beside the Information Kiosk which is located right beside the arrivals door.

Students are then taken to either their residence or to their host family.



AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Return airport transfers are included with Classic Homestay and Classic Campus bookings. For other students, transfers from Pearson International airport can be booked for a charge of \$105. Transfers are compulsory unless students are accompanied by a guardian. In this case, EC must be given a *No Airport Transfers Waiver Form*. Students must arrive on Saturday and depart on Saturday. If students require transfers from alternative locations, fees will be quoted upon request. If the student is travelling as an unaccompanied minor with the airline a fee of \$80 one way is charged.



It is vitally important that EC Toronto is made aware of any last minute flight changes by calling the emergency arrival phone number.

Please send information regarding arrival time, flight number, airline, name of airport and terminal number to EC Head office a month before the student's arrival. If this information does not reach us at least 7 days prior to the student's arrival, EC Toronto will not be responsible for providing airport transfers to the student and will not offer any compensation to students who have not been collected because of this.

JOURNEY TO SCHOOL

Directions to EC Toronto classrooms at 89 Chestnut Junior Campus are as follows for:

Homestay students:

89 Chestnut is on the Yonge subway line, two blocks west of Dundas subway station.

Campus students:

Student accommodation and lessons are both on campus.

FIRST DAY AT SCHOOL

On their first day, students should arrive at the Junior Center at 08:30. Students must bring:

- proof of insurance
- comfortable walking shoes
- water bottle
- pen/pencils
- paper
- Toronto Public Transit Pass will be given to students during orientation (do not purchase one)

PLACEMENT TEST

Between 9:00 and 11:00 students will take their placement test which will assess them in all key skill areas, allowing academic staff to place students in the relevant group for their ability.

WELCOME TALK

Students will have a welcome talk after their placement test. An orientation will be held from 11:00 – 12:30, consisting of academic, accommodation and activities information. Students will receive:

- schedule of classes
- directions to class and the dining hall
- activity calendar
- students will have a group lunch from 12:30 - 13.30 and then will begin the first activity students will receive their textbooks at their first class which will take place on Tuesday morning at 9:00

STUDENT HANDBOOK

A junior student handbook will be given on the first day of classes. This Handbook contains activity descriptions, a map of Toronto, a map of the school campus, a subway/commuter map, homestay responsibilities and emergency contact information.
