

Preparation programme for entry into the British educational system

Caxton College offers a secondary education programme to students who aim to improve English skills while studying the British curriculum subjects. Pupils can enjoy an international experience and gain the qualifications that will allow them to continue their education in a British school.



Students are taught by qualified teachers, who specialise in English as a foreign language as well as individual subjects. Pupils are mentored by a personal tutor, who guides and encourages them throughout the programme. Each class has a maximum of ten students, ensuring a high level of individual attention.

Other aspects of the programme include:

- Regular assessments and reports sent to parents.
- Examinations appropriate to pupils' age and ability: CAE, DELE, IGCSE, etc.
- The use of technology in the classroom such as iPads, Apple TV and interactive whiteboards.
- Option for accommodation with carefully selected host families.
- Excellent facilities such as science laboratories, IT suites, art rooms, tennis courts, two 7-a-side football pitches, indoor and outdoor pools and fitness rooms.
- Participation in whole school events such as: assemblies, trips, house activities, etc.



CISC Junior – 12 to 14 years of age

This course focuses on developing study skills and independent thinking, understanding and communicating in English, British Curriculum subjects including Mathematics, English as a Second Language, Spanish as a Second Language*, Science and Social subjects, and Physical Education.

* Students whose mother tongue is Spanish will attend "Lengua Española".

Entry requirements:

- Reports from previous school demonstrating good subject knowledge and a positive attitude.
- English level B1 on the Common European Framework.
- Pass grades in entrance tests in English and Mathematics.
- Personal interview at Caxton College or via Skype.

CISC Senior – 14 to 16 years of age

The aim of this course is to prepare students for the IGCSE examinations allowing them to gain entry into the Sixth Form. British schools require five or more IGCSE passes at grade C or above to continue onto further education.

IGCSE examinations include: Mathematics, English as a Second Language, Spanish as a Second Language* , Science and Social Studies subjects.
